



Recycling Cart Guide

- Place **all** recyclable material **loosely** into your cart. There is no need to separate paper from glass, aluminium, plastic and tin.
- **DO NOT** place recyclables in plastic bags!
- **DO NOT** place trash in your recycling cart!
- **NO PLASTIC BAGS ALLOWED!!!**
- **All recyclables must fit inside your cart with the lid closed.**
 - For overflow recyclables, you may:
 - Safe for a future collection date
 - Ask a neighbor if they have extra room in their cart.
- Cardboard boxes should be broken down and possibly cut to fit into the cart loosely.
- Place your recycling cart with the front of the lid facing the street no more than three (3) feet from curb.
- There needs to be at least three (3) feet between your cart and any other objects such as parked cars, light poles, mailboxes, and other carts.
- Brillion's recycling schedule has not changed. If your recycling is the same day as your schedule day for garbage collection, be sure to place garbage and recycling carts on opposites of the driveway. If you do not have a driveway place containers 10 feet apart.
- Do not place on top of snow banks, they must be ground level.
- Make sure to place your cart at the curb either by 6:00 AM of the day of pick-up or the night before. Please remove your cart within 24 hours after collection.
